

Virginia FAMIS MOMS (Medicaid for Pregnant Women)

What is FAMIS MOMS?

The FAMIS MOMS program provides healthcare coverage to pregnant women. It encourages pregnant women to receive early and regular prenatal care to increase the chances of a healthy birth. FAMIS MOMS is available to women who are:

- Currently uninsured
- Pregnant
- Within the sixty-day period after their pregnancies end
- Not eligible for a state employee health plan

How does it work?

FAMIS MOMS provides complete healthcare benefits during pregnancy and for two months following the end of the pregnancy. FAMIS MOMS also has a special program for women with high-risk pregnancies. Healthcare services are provided through managed care organizations or fee-for-service offices, depending on where you live.

Immigration Status

To receive FAMIS you must be a US citizen or qualified alien.

How does one apply?

- Start the application process over the phone.
You can start your application over the phone by calling FAMIS at 1 (866) 873-2647. The FAMIS representative will ask questions about where you live, who is applying for health insurance, the household make-up, and your family's income. The next business day a pre-filled application will be mailed to you. You will then need to review the application to make sure it is correct, and complete any missing information.
