What are the Utility Discount Programs (UDP)?

The Utility Discount Programs offer lower energy rates to low- and moderate-income households.

How does it work?

Local utility companies offer discounted electricity, gas, water and phone service. Amounts of discounts vary widely. Participating companies include:

- Potomac Electric Power Company (PEPCO)
- Washington Gas Company
- Verizon
- District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority
