

Adult Health and Dental Partnership

What is the Adult Health and Dental Partnership?

The Adult Health and Partnership provides medical and dental services at a reduced cost for low-income adults who cannot afford or do not have access to health insurance and do not qualify for Medicaid or Medicare.

How does it work?

Participants receive care in one of two ways:

- The Kaiser Permanente HMO "Bridge Program" provides complete health care benefits for a maximum period of 24 months.
- A doctor or dentist (not affiliated with Kaiser Permanente) provides care for a reduced fee. Participating doctors and dentists can be found by contacting Northern Virginia Family Service.
