

School Age Child Care (SACC)

What is School Age Child Care (SACC)?

SACC provides child care before and after school hours for children in kindergarten through sixth grade. SACC is also available during school winter, spring and summer vacations. Service is offered at Fairfax County Public Schools, and a parent must live in The City of Falls Church, The City of Fairfax, or Fairfax County. SACC is available to parents and caretakers who are:

- ▣ Working 30 hours or more per week
- ▣ Attending school full time
- ▣ Attending job training
- ▣ Medically unable to work and/or care for a child

How does it work?

A parent or caretaker's cost/fee for before and after-school programs is based on family income. Program hours are 7:15AM to school starting time and end of school to 6:15PM.
