

## MD Child and Dependent Care Credit (CDCC)

### What is the Maryland Child and Dependent Care Credit (CDCC)?

The Maryland CDCC is an income tax credit for low- and moderate-income families. The CDCC provides a tax credit to those with children under 13 and other dependants, as well as to those providing care to the children/dependants.

### How does it work?

To qualify, family income must be no more than \$50,000. To claim the credit, you must complete Part B of tax Form 502CR and indicate the credit on Maryland Forms 502, 505 or 515. Those eligible for the federal child care tax credit (dependent care credit) can apply 32.5% of the federal credit to their Maryland taxes.
