

MD Children's Health Program

What is MCHP?

The Maryland Children's Health Program (MCHP) provides full health benefits for uninsured children up to age 19 and pregnant women of any age. In some cases, having health insurance will not prevent eligibility for MCHP.

How does it work?

The program allows participants to choose their primary care physician (main doctor) from a list of providers. Children's coverage is very complete and covers well doctor visits, dental, vision, prescriptions, and mental health services. Pregnant women can receive coverage of:

- Prenatal and post-partum doctor visits
- Prescriptions (including vitamins)
- Family planning services
- Dental
- Vision
- Transportation to appointments

How does one apply?

- Call the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services (MCDHHS) office to ask that an application be mailed to you.
- Print out and submit an online [MCHP Application Form](#). Applications are also available at WIC Centers and local hospitals and schools.

Applications can be completed at home and mailed in or dropped off at an MCDHHS office. Case managers are available to assist you at MCDHHS offices. Those found eligible for MCHP will receive an enrollment packet in the mail.
