What is the Maryland Pharmacy Discount Program?

The Maryland Pharmacy Discount Program helps Maryland residents who are enrolled in Medicare and do not have government or private prescription drug coverage. Recipients can receive benefits from the Maryland Pharmacy Discount Program and the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program at the same time.

Medbank of Maryland

Medbank of Maryland helps disabled and low-income people apply for free and low-cost medicines, as long as they are not enrolled in another prescription drug program. People can qualify if they are not Maryland residents but are treated by a doctor in Maryland.

Senior Prescription Drug Program (SPDP)

A drug program for Maryland residents who *are* eligible for Medicare, but do not have prescription drug coverage.

Maryland Aids Drug Assistance Plan (MADAP)

MADAP helps people who are not eligible for the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program, but who have an income at or below 400% of the current Federal Poverty Level. MADAP participants pay no co-payments on prescriptions from the pharmacy, but may have to pay a monthly participation fee based on income.

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
