

Montgomery County Rental Assistance Program (RAP)

What is the Montgomery County Rental Assistance Program (RAP)?

RAP helps low- and moderate-income US citizens living in Maryland pay their rent. Help is available to those who are:

- Over 62 years old
- Disabled
- Sharing a home (a household of 2 or more persons)

How does it Work?

Eligible households can receive between \$50-\$200 per month in assistance. Total household assets (savings, investment, property) must be less than \$10,000.
