

Electric Universal Services Program (EUSP)

What is the Electric Universal Services Program (EUSP)?

EUSP helps low- and moderate-income residents pay overdue electric bills. The program also helps increase energy efficiency to reduce the cost of future bills.

How does it work?

Eligibility is based on income, but you may automatically be eligible if you are low income and elderly or disabled, receiving Temporary Cash Assistance, Supplemental Security Income, Food Stamps or certain veterans or Social Security disability benefits.
