

Maryland Energy Assistance Program (MEAP)

What is the Maryland Energy Assistance Program (MEAP)?

MEAP helps low- and moderate-income Maryland citizens pay home heating bills.

How does it work?

MEAP makes bill payments directly to your utility/energy company. MEAP also provides help with repair of broken or inefficient furnaces. Eligibility is based on income. You may automatically be eligible if you are already receiving Temporary Cash Assistance, Supplemental Security Income, Food Stamps, or Social Security disability benefits.
